

THE MINNEHAHA COUNTY COMMISSION CONVENED IN JOINT SESSION WITH THE SIOUX FALLS CITY COUNCIL AT 5:00 P.M., June 16, 2003, pursuant to adjournment on June 10, 2003. Commissioners present were Pekas, Twedt, Hajek, Kolbe and Zweep. Sandy Kinder, Deputy Auditor, was also present.

City Council Members present: Beninga, Howes, Kavanaugh, Knudson, Rust, Smith, Stagers, and Mayor Munson. Councilman Gleason absent.

Chairman Pekas called the meeting to order.

VACATION OF RIGHT-OF-WAY

Phil Kappen, Assistant Planner, was present for the scheduled hearing to consider Vacation of Public Right-Of-Way legally described as Ted Drive which is 66 feet wide and lies between Tracts 10 and 11 in Iverson Tracts N ½ NE 1/4 Section 30-T101N-R48W of the 5th P.M, Minnehaha County South Dakota. Cheryll Ahnberg, Petitioner, was present to answer questions. Tony Everson, City Engineer, addressed concerns of future development in the area and recommended denial of the request. Shannon Ausen, Civil Engineer, stated there are drainage problems in the area to the east of Ted Drive and future development of a through street to the east may not be possible. Gary Colwill, City Attorney, explained that each Body must vote affirmatively to approve the request to vacate. City Council MOTION by Council Member Howes, seconded by Council Member Smith to approve the vacation of Ted Drive, motion failed to pass the City. No action taken by the County Commission.

MOTION by Zweep, seconded by Kolbe to adjourn until 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, June 17, 2003. 5 ayes.
