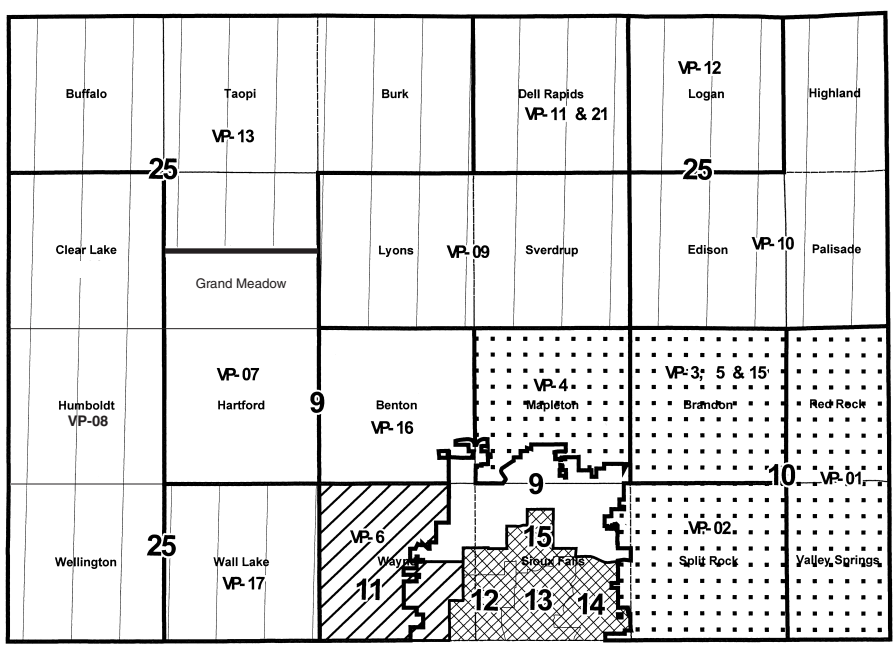

The polls will be open from **7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.** Voters with disabilities may contact the Auditor's office at 367-4220 for information and special assistance in absentee voting or polling place accessibility.

**All registered voters may vote in the Special Congressional Election.**

### VOTING RIGHTS

Any voter who can't mark a ballot because the voter has a physical disability or can't read, may ask any person they choose to help them vote. Any voter may ask for instruction in the proper procedure for voting. Any voter at the polling place prior to 7:00 p.m. is allowed to cast a ballot. If your voting rights have been violated, you may call the Minnehaha County Auditor at 367-4220, the SD Secretary of State at 888-703-5328, or the Minnehaha County State's Attorney at 367-4226.

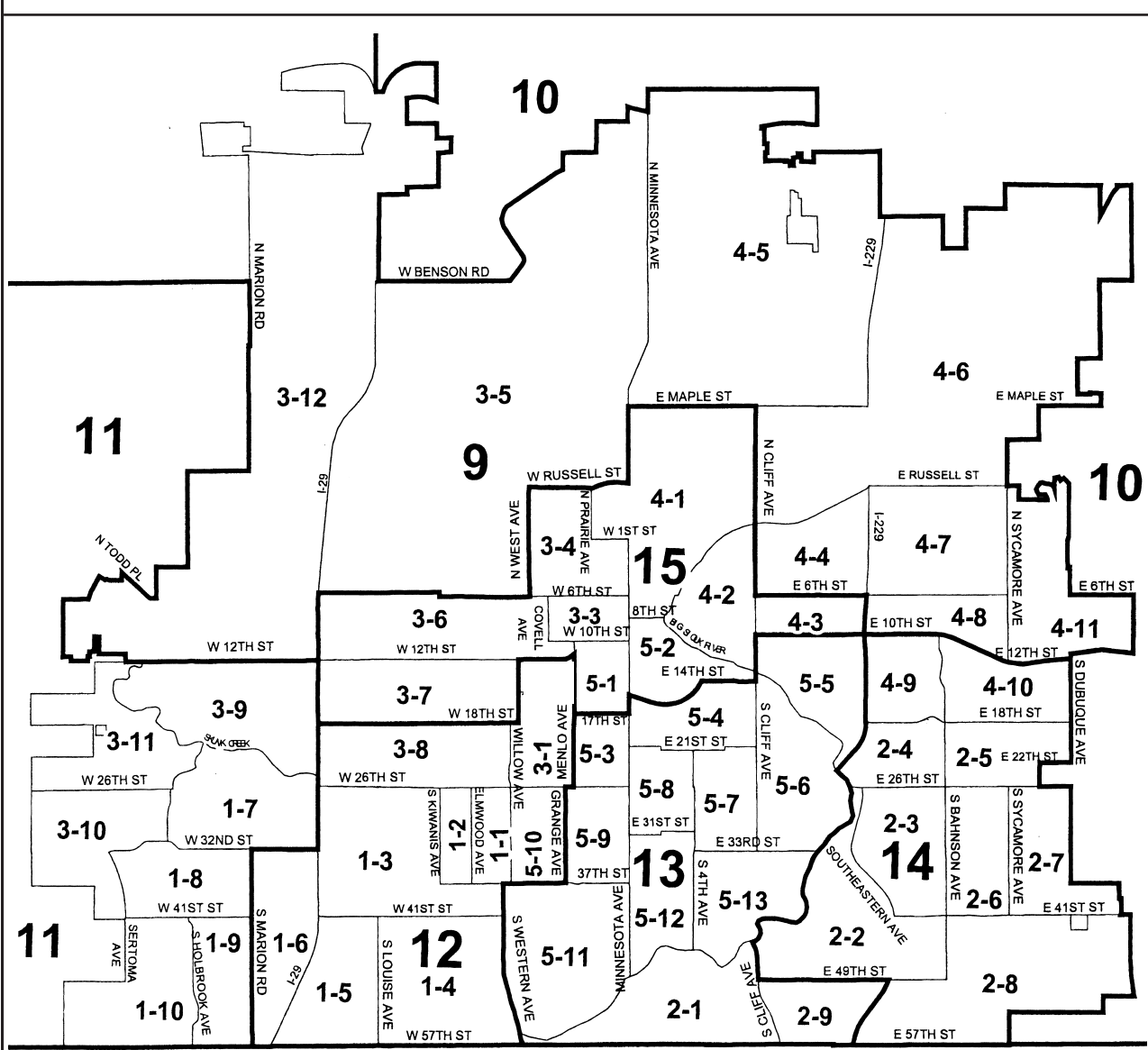
### ELECTION CRIMES
